Founded in 1947, PFCU has approximately 10,000 members throughout southeastern Michigan. Parkway offers a full range of financial services to member groups associated with some of the biggest names in the Detroit automobile industry.

When parkway's largest employer membership group opened a second plant at a distant location management at first felt members could still be served from their original facility. Unfortunately, the 25 mile distance began costing Parkway customers to other credit unions and was faced with losing the entire employee group.

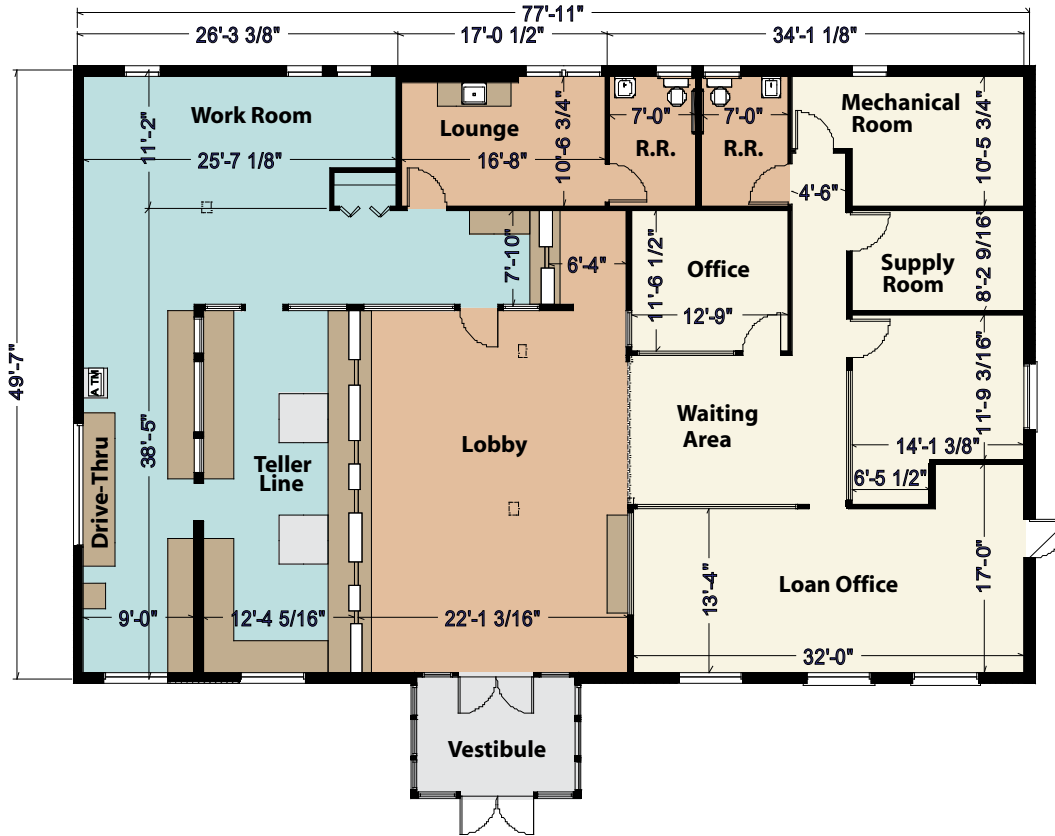

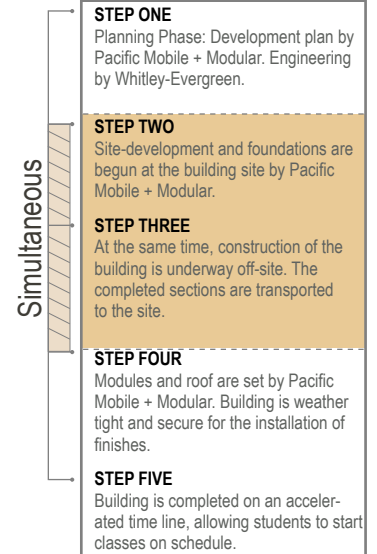
